Confidently Knocking

Here are some questions for all of us to really ponder. They are not just yes or no answers. You must answer with your heart. These revelations are between you and God.

- 1. Jesus knocks on the door of your heart. (Revelation 3:20) Do you open it? Do you open it just a tiny bit, or fling the door wide open?
- 2. If you do let Jesus in, do you sit at His feet and listen to all He says, like Mary, or are you too concerned with what you must do to make yourself presentable to Him?
